Document Summary:

This is a handwritten letter from Abu-'Abd-al-Razzaq of the Sector's Public and Media Relations, possibly addressed to Abu-Khaldun, listing amount paid to certain individuals such as 500 USD to Abu-Turki as he owed him 1,000 USD, and requested the appropriation of 700 USD to help Yasin al-Mutlaq. He also visited Sheikh Husayn al-Barghash and gave him a present because he was sick. The letter also outlined the distribution of MP3 players to various individuals including, Abu-Khalid 'Ubur al-Dhira', Abu-Usamah Sheikh 'Awdah Zawba' al-Khadir, Abu-Khaldun, Sheikh Khalil Ibrahim Julan, Khalid al-Falluji Zawba'.

In the name of God, Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful

In the name of Allah, the Lord of the truly truth, prayer and peace upon Prophet Muhammad. No God except Allah, and Muhammad his messenger, thereafter,

- Praise be to Allah, I visited brother Sheikh Abu-Turki and presenting him a gift, and according to information quoted from trustful sources, he owed the amount of 1,000 USD, I paid him 500 USD, and the remaining balance is 500 USD. We ask Allah to facilitate us to help this man.

- I also recently visited Sheikh Yasin al-Mutlaq and discussed with him the recent developments and I gave him a gift for his return from performing 'Umrah [Minor Pilgrim] in the form of lamb] and a traditional robe. I request allotting 700 USD to help him for his honorable service and good reputation, and also for being a good ambassador for the blessed State.

- I also visited Brother Sheikh Husayn al-Barghash on 05 NOV 2009 and gave him a gift for his family in the form of gold jewelry and he was very happy. I told him that the Sheikhs are praying for his speedy recovery, and he asked with obvious emotions, and tears in his eyes, whether the sheikhs still remember their conditions, and I said even more and they want to know every minor and major thing about you.

- I also gave MP3 players to Suhayb Bin-Sannan Mosque, and I started a training course for 150 girls and boys. A few young people were selected to conduct the upcoming training and an agreement was concluded to open specialized training. I suggest assigning a computer to the mosque for teaching the youths, maintaining the training from gifts and to look after the instructors.
